## The Get App'ed Diversity in Apprenticeships Programme

Apprenticeships are an excellent way of gaining qualifications and workplace experiences for young people. Young Apprentices earn while they learn, experience a wide range of opportunities and build relationships in the industry in which they wish to progress.

Get App'ed Diversity in Apprenticeship Project is a unique scheme, funded by the Skills Funding Agency and the European Social Fund. The project aims to increase participation in apprenticeships by groups that are currently under-represented. As such, to be eligible for the programme you must be:

- Aged 16-18 years old; and
- From a Black, Asian and Ethnic Minority Groups; or
- Have learning difficulties or disabilities

The project will use innovative approaches that improve engagement, recruitment, retention and progression of young people aged 16-18 years from under-represented communities and genders. We are especially focussing recruiting young people into non traditional apprenticeships e.g. females into ICT.
